Were these models based on the 'Gibson Girl'? She was supposedly the personification of the feminine ideal of physical beauty, as portrayed by the b/w illustrations of artist Charles Dana Gibson during a 20-year period that spanned the late 19th and early 20th centuries in the USA. The artist saw his creation as representing the composite of "thousands of American girls". A 'Gibson Girl' was tall and slender, with an ample bosom, hips and buttocks; she had an exaggerated S-curve torso shape achieved by wearing a swan-bill corset; and her hair was piled high upon her head in bouffant or pompadour fashion. Many women posed for Gibson Girl-style illustrations, including his wife, Irene Langhorne, the sister of Viscountess Nancy Astor. Gibson's fictional images of her, published in newspapers and magazines during the Belle Époque, were extremely popular and much merchandise was produced. By the outbreak of WW1 changing fashions caused the Gibson Girl to fall out of favour as women preferred more practical clothing. (The cartoon above, c.1900, is titled "The Gibson Girls flirting with the open-air")

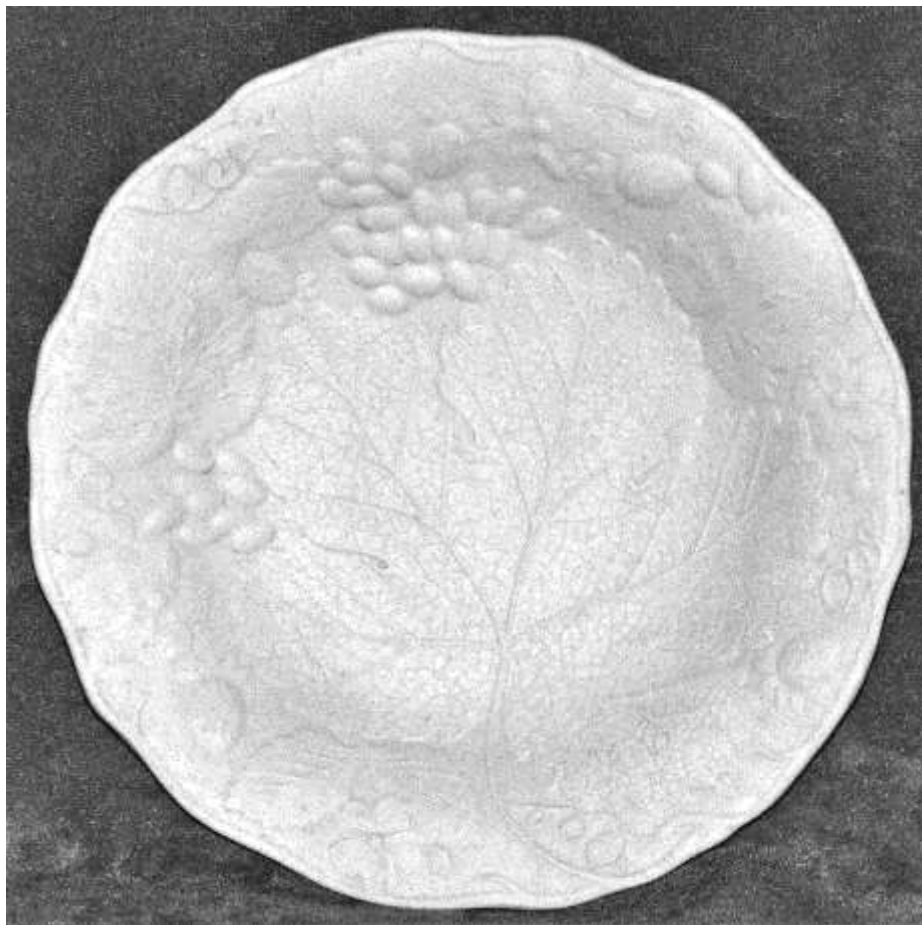

In the ‘Goss Hawk’ December 2009 I started a series of photographs, an attempt to build a complete photo-record of all the Historic Models, in all their sizes and variations, together side by side. Starting off the series was the Aberdeen Bronze Pot, illustrated in the three regular sizes. However, an example of the 4th size - the large model with unusually short legs – was never seen, despite several appeals in the magazine. In fact, a good argument was made to question its existence at all. How wrong! And 14 years later here is the proof; and not only is this the missing model, but it carries the very largest example, of the most appropriate enamel transfer, of the Regalia of Scotland. A double-super scarce variant of one of the more common models.

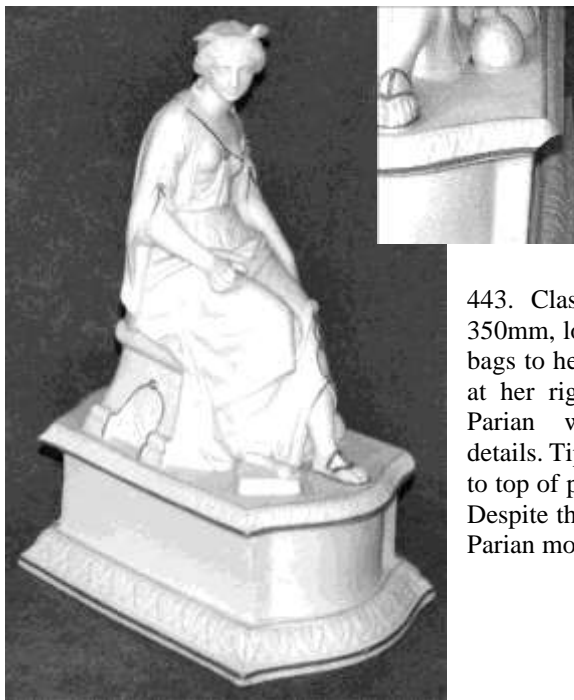
