79. Evangeline Goss as coloured lid to a casket. The casket base heavily restored across one of the corners; the top with the sleeping child in rather good condition but for one of the corner tassels having been crudely restuck.		10
80. As above, just a couple of top edge nibbles to the base; the sleeping child top has the bottom two tassels broken off. (Because of the varying shrinkage rates in kiln firing, the tops and bottoms of this and the above model are not interchangeable)		10
81. Shakespeare white bust socle/octagonal plinth "From the monument at Stratford-on-Avon 1616". Left shoulder and down the back left edge some disfiguring kiln roughness; to the right side of body a 20mm diam flake chip to the edge. Displays much better than it sounds, and a scarce model.		10
82. Georgiana Jewitt white wall vase, head in high profile, flowers to head broken as are the flowers at the neck, also varying sized edge nibbles. Worst damage is to the back wall hanger which is missing for the top third. Yet when it is hanging high, again, it looks much better than it sounds.		5
83. Cherub, white, asleep on a coverlet. Usually on a casket and coloured (see 'Price Guide' pages 103 & 108) this is screwed to a metal frame with 4 screw holes. The screw stands proud at the back which makes display difficult. And when I took the nut off, I still cannot remove the parian from the metal. Still a lovely item of parian – if you can find a way to display the model.		25
